New Policy Regarding Changes to Plans or Cancelations for Plan Review

09.20.2024

Once a plan review is created and a review number is issued, the following will take place for any changes to plans or cancellations/voids of plan reviews.

- 1. A new plan review must be created for completely new plans, not revisions.
- 2. New building and or trade permits must be issued for the new plan review.
- 3. Once fees have been paid, a refund must be requested.
 - a. To request a refund, the plan review number, address, and reason for the refund must be provided on company letterhead, no exceptions. This request must be emailed to Anisa Smith, <u>acsmith@cabarruscounty.us</u> for processing.
 - b. Plan Review Fee will not be refunded.
 - c. Permit/Inspections fees will be available for and 80% refund.
 - d. WSACC Fees
 - i. 100% refund of WSACC will be available if the request is within the same month the fees are paid.
 - ii. If refund request is after the same month paid, you must contact WSACC directly for a refund. info@wsacc.org, (704) 786-1783.
 - e. City of Concord zoning review fees will not be refunded.
 - f. Homeowner Recovery Fee (residential) may be available for a refund.
 - i. The refund will be determined by when the request is submitted and when the fees have been sent to the North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors.
 - ii. Once Cabarrus County sends the funds for the Homeowner Recovery Fund, you must contact the North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors to see if a refund is available. Homeowners Recovery Fund – NC Licensing Board for General Contractors (nclbgc.org)
- 4. Refund requests will not be accepted after 6 months from the payment date.
- 5. Refund requests will not be accepted once any inspection has been completed on any permits associated to the plan review.
