

## Antique Automobile Value Exclusion Application

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §105-330.9, antique automobiles are designated a special class of property under Article V, Sec. 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and are eligible for assessment at a reduced tax valuation. If qualified, they shall be assessed at the lower of their true value or five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

To determine qualification, the owner must **file an affirmation with the assessor of the county in which the property is located** that all five conditions of the statute have been met. This form, or any appeal of initial value, must be filed **within 30 days of the date the taxes are due**. The assessor reserves the right to deny the qualification of any automobile deemed not to qualify.
