## INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAXPAYER

Step 1 – County Assessor's Office, Governmental Center, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor

The Assessor's Office will assist the taxpayer in completing information below in order to list a Manufactured home. If this is an older manufactured home, the Assessor's Office will verify That it was listed previously. If not listed previously, the Assessor's Office will prepare Information on the manufactured home for the Tax Collector's Office.

Step 2 – Tax Collector's Office, Governmental Center, 1st Floor

The Tax Collector's Office will verify that all taxes are paid. Any unpaid balances must be paid Before a moving permit is issued.

Step 3 – Determination as to real/personal property status.

Step 4 – Building Inspections Office, Governmental Center, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor

Taxpayer requests building permit for manufactured home.

North Carolina General Statute 105-273 defines Manufactured Housing as "Real Property" as follows:

Real property means not only the land itself, but also buildings, structures, improvements, and permanent fixtures on the land. These terms also mean a manufactured home as defined in G.S. 143-143.9(6) if it is a residential structure; has moving hitch, wheels, and axles removed, and is placed upon a permanent foundation on land owned by the owner of the manufactured home.

The manufactured home will be considered real property if all the following criteria are met:
