

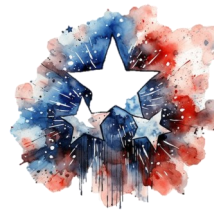
## ELECTION DAY CHECKLIST

- ✓ Inform Chief Judge if you are working Election Day and cannot make it.
- ✓ Wear comfortable clothing and dress in layers to account for varying temperatures.
- ✓ Leave your campaign buttons and political attire at home.
- ✓ Discussion of politics is not permitted while working at the polls.
- ✓ Arrange for enough food and drinks for the entire day.
- ✓ Cell phones must be turned off in the polling place.
- ✓ Smoking is not permitted in the voting enclosure and all building rules should be followed.
- ✓ Make accommodations for children and pets on Election Day. You will not be able to leave the site unless it is an emergency.
- ✓ Bring your medications with you, if necessary.



## POSITIONS

- ★ The CHIEF JUDGE is the head official and is in charge of Election Day activities as well as picking up and returning Election Day supplies.
- ★ The JUDGES work closely with the Chief Judge and are responsible for conducting the election in the Chief Judge's absence. They must sign all official documents and serve on a panel to resolve any challenges.
- ★ The ASSISTANTS serve where needed and at the discretion and direction of the Chief Judge.
- ★ RESERVE ASSISTANTS attend training seminars and are available to go to any precinct and work on Election Day, if needed.
- ★ EARLY VOTING workers work during the weeks prior to an election when early voting is being conducted.

**NOTICE TO APPLICANT - PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU SIGN BELOW**

Persons appointed to these positions must be registered voters and residents of the county in which the precinct is located, of good repute, and able to read and write. Not more than one Judge in each precinct shall belong to the same political party as the Chief Judge. No person shall be eligible who holds any elective office under the government of the United States or of the State of North Carolina or any political subdivision thereof. No person shall be eligible to serve as a precinct official who is a candidate for nomination or election. No person shall be eligible to serve as a precinct official who holds any office in a state, congressional district, county, or precinct political party or political organization, or who is a manager or treasurer for any candidate or political party, provided however that the position of delegate to a political party convention shall not be considered an office for the purpose of this subsection. The following categories of relatives are prohibited from serving as precinct officials of the same precinct: spouse, child, spouse of a child, sister or brother. No precinct official who is the wife, husband, mother, father, son, daughter, brother or sister of any candidate for nomination or election may serve as precinct official during any primary or election in which such candidate participates. The Board of Elections may remove you as a precinct election official for misbehavior or neglect of duty.
